Trumpet Call has presented the PILTC (Prayer and Intercession Leaders Training Course) in and about Cape Town since September 2000. Through the years, many students have expressed the desire to be able to present the material to their own people at home, whose circumstances were such that they could not attend the PILTC sessions.

Recordings:

During 2007 we've professionally recorded the PILTC sessions in English, and are recording them in Afrikaans this year. The English sessions of **Course 1** (of 4) of last year has been edited and are now available in a DVD set @ R1000 per set (containing 18 DVDs).

Facilitators' Course:

In order to empower believers to present this course in a lounge setting via DVD on a TV screen, Trumpet Call will be hosting a **FACILITATORS' COURSE** for those who desire to act as PILTC Facilitators in the future. Doing the Facilitators' Course does not put anyone under any obligation. A very successful Facilitators' Course has already been hosted in Bloemfontein during August.

Here's how it's supposed to work:

The basic idea is that facilitators host the PILTC in a lounge for a small group of students. Only facilitators who have completed the Facilitators' Course, and is in possession of a **Certificate of Completion**, would be entitled to charge their students a **course fee**. Having hosted PILTC **Course 1** for 4 or more students, such a facilitator would then have his R1000 back, which would enable him to acquire the DVD set of **Course 2**, as soon as it becomes available. This process then repeats itself until the facilitator has acquired all 4 sets of DVDs, from whence he could start to make a small profit for round 2 of the PILTC when he facilitates that.

This is a wonderful tool by which we could literally train **thousands of leaders of prayer and intercession** all over South Africa - much quicker and more effectively than in the past! In the past eight years, Trumpet Call had only about 3000 attendees at the PILTC in total. Via the DVDs, we can train the same number within 2 years, with many thousands to come after that!

Can you sponsor a less privileged person?

Trumpet Call would also like to encourage those who have the ability to do so, or simply feels urged by the Holy Spirit to do so, to **sponsor** the R1000 (or a part of it) for an underprivileged person who could not afford the amount. Such a person needs to have access to a TV and DVD player though! For the sake of the Kingdom, we need to get the PILTC going in **townships**! And if somebody has the vision to facilitate the PILTC in **prisons**, please contact us!

Afrikaans sets:

Persons who would rather like their DVD set in Afrikaans as soon as it becomes available, would be allowed to **swop** their English set for an Afrikaans one (provided the English one is in excellent condition!). The Afrikaans would not be available within less than a year, though.
